PURPOSE AND SCOPE OF REPORT:

PURPOSE

The purpose of this document is to report to the customer the appraiser's opinion of the overall condition of the subject vehicle.

With features such as a high performance 5.7 Liter V-8 motor, 4-speed automatic transmission, power front disc brakes, and a custom leather upholstered interior this Hot Rod is built for performance. It also has air conditioning, keyless start, overhead console and tilt steering.


